

Advisory Mission Statement Examples

The purpose of advisory is to know students well by implanting the concept of personalization on a daily basis with particular emphasis on helping students to develop as a community of learners born of respect, trust, and courage. (Souhegan)

To provide students with a small, supportive community in which they can learn and practice the behaviors and skills needed to become successful, responsible, and involved leaders in the community. (Souhegan)

To offer personalized education that helps students to be successful today, graduate tomorrow, and prepare for the future by supporting their personal, social, physical, and academic growth. (Littleton)

The focus of the advisory will be on goal-setting, study skill development, interpersonal skills and college/career planning. (Laconia)

The purpose of Advisory is to create a cohesive, ongoing community of learners and to provide all students with a connection to a staff member who will guide and support them with their academic, personal, and social growth. (Keene)

To build a sense of community and to get to know each student well enough to support them with academic and life decisions. (The Advisory Guide)

To provide systematic opportunities for students to access academic acceleration, advising, interventions, and supports, within a structure of community and mentoring. (Colchester)

There is a formal, ongoing program through which each student has an adult in the school, in addition to the school counselor, who knows the student well and assists the student in achieving the school's 21st century learning expectations. (NEASC)
